INTRODUCTION

Certified Innovation Organization is a unique certification reserved exclusively for businesses and government agencies. Through a process of independent third-party review and assessment, the CInOrg establishes that your organization has demonstrated a certain level of maturity and capability with respect to being able to consistently deliver on short, medium, and long term innovation and growth endeavors. This distinguishes your organization among its peers and competitors as being capable of delivering leading-edge value and customer experiences to its markets.

CInOrg certification is awarded at three distinct levels, corresponding to increasing levels of innovation maturity and capability. These three levels, from the least to the most capable, are:

1. Originator
2. Champion
3. Leader

What Organizations Should Apply

Any organization – whether for-profit, nonprofit, or governmental agency – that depends on the use of innovation in pursuing strategic aims such as growth, market leadership, and customer satisfaction will benefit and should apply.

Manufacturing Companies – High Tech, Hard Goods, Fast-Moving Consumer Goods, Food and Beverage, Pharmaceuticals, etc.

Service Organizations – Banking, Finance, Insurance, Hospitality, Travel, etc.

Nonprofit Institutions – Schools, Universities, Research Institutes, Libraries, Hospitals, etc.

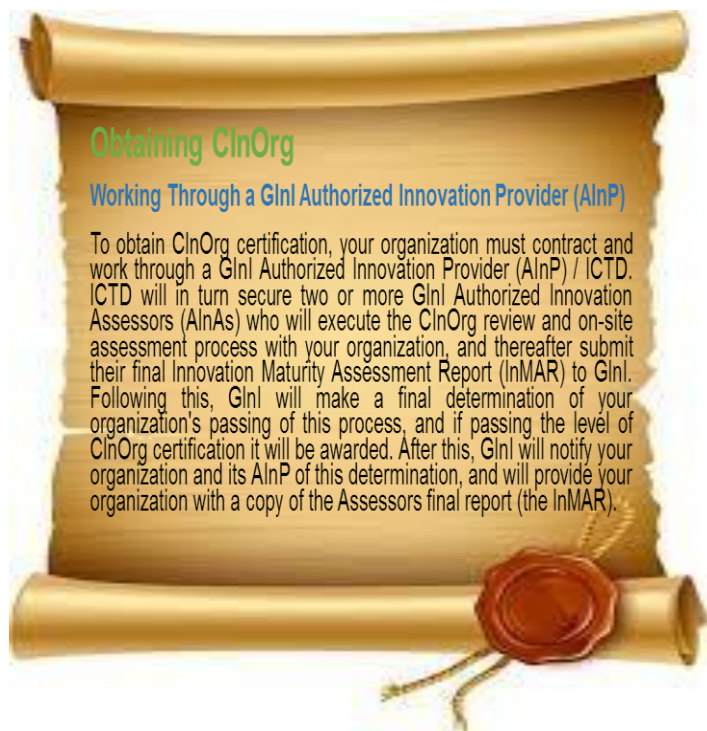
Government Agencies – Economic Development, Infrastructure, Transportation, Utilities, Social Welfare, etc.

The Administrative Processing Fee for CInOrg certification is **5,000 USD**. This is to be paid initially and then annually on the anniversary of your organization's original certification date.

Obtaining CInOrg

Working Through a GInI Authorized Innovation Provider (AInP)

To obtain CInOrg certification, your organization must contract and work through a GInI Authorized Innovation Provider (AInP) / ICTD. ICTD will in turn secure two or more GInI Authorized Innovation Assessors (AInAs) who will execute the CInOrg review and on-site assessment process with your organization, and thereafter submit their final Innovation Maturity Assessment Report (InMAR) to GInI. Following this, GInI will make a final determination of your organization's passing of this process, and if passing the level of CInOrg certification it will be awarded. After this, GInI will notify your organization and its AInP of this determination, and will provide your organization with a copy of the Assessors final report (the InMAR).
